



Albertina L. Graumann

August 23, 1928 - September 6, 2019

Albertina was born on August 23, 1928, on the family farm in Bessie, Oklahoma, to Gottfried and Rosina “Rosie” (Gerner) Mueller. She was the ninth child of ten and was given her paternal grandmother’s name. Albertina was baptized on May 16, 1937, and confirmed in her faith of our Lord on March 29, 1942. She grew up and attended schools in the Bessie and Cordell area but attended Granite schools her freshman and senior years while living with one of her sisters whose husband was away in the armed services. After graduating high school in May 1946 she returned to Cordell and became a licensed beautician.

While in Granite, she met Leonard Graumann. Over the next three years, they remained in touch through church events and were married on September 11, 1949, at Zion Lutheran Church in Oklahoma City. Albertina put her career on hold to help Leonard with the farming operation and raise her four children. However, she was committed to her profession and managed to keep her beautician skills sharp on her children’s hair.

Albertina’s warm smile and sweet gentle spirit blessed many people. Her love for the Lord was sincere and she could often times be heard singing hymns of praise throughout the day. Being a loving mother and grandmother, she always put her family’s needs above her own. Like many folks, one of her proudest moments in life was becoming a grandmother. She enjoyed all

aspects of the farm especially tending to animals, managing her vegetable garden and “windshield farming”. Noontime around the family farm would find work trucks crowded under the mulberry shade tree because no one wanted to miss the opportunity to indulge themselves in her cooking.

Throughout her life, Albertina was an active member of St. John’s Lutheran Church participating in the church choir, Lutheran Women’s Missionary League, Sunday School teacher and Altar Guild. She was involved in the Oklahoma Association of Conservation Districts’ Auxiliary and enjoyed traveling with Leonard and other members to attend conservation meetings and conventions throughout the country. She supported her family in all of their school activities. She was most comfortable avoiding the spotlight and quietly working behind the scenes on any project or need that arose. However, this did not apply to OU football where she possessed great knowledge of the game and was very boisterous.

Albertina went to be with the Lord on September 6, 2019. She was preceded in death by her husband Leonard; sons Keith and Steve; grandson Patrick Hudson; her siblings Minnie, Welita, Regina, Lorena, Golda, Wilbert, Marvin, Leonard and her parents. She is survived by her daughters Patsy Hudson of Granite, OK, and Aline and Steve Perry of Southlake, TX, her sister Anna Doty of Amarillo, TX, and sister-in-law Lydia Graumann of Granite, OK. Also surviving her are grandchildren Allison and Tyler Richey of Altus, OK and Kylie and Tyler Graumann of Granite, OK; great grandchildren Wade Richey, Griffin Richey and Brayden Hudson along with beloved nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.

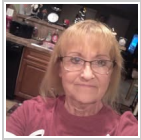
