Allen Wayne Elkins passed from this life on December 6, 2023 in Elk City, OK at the age of 63. He was born in Seminole, Oklahoma on July 12, 1960 to Carol Wayne Elkins and Eleanor (Porter) Elkins. Allen attended school in Maud, OK, Seminole, OK, Lone Wolf, OK, Sentinel, OK, and he graduated at Mangum, OK. Allen married shortly after school to Judy, and she had two children, JP and Tee. After the marriage, Allen worked different jobs before he went to USAO of Chickasha where he graduated with a bachelors in Kinesiology. He was a student coach at Chickasha High School Football for 3 years. Allen also worked at Chickasha Industrial for some time. In his second marriage to Sharon, she had two children, Neil and April, and Austin was born in 1991. Allen loved fishing, softball, and bowling. He was known as a "Horseshoe Champion" with Jim Harden. Allen was injured in an accident on October 25, 2000, that changed the course of his life. After that accident, he had a cage in his neck, and in late August 2014, he had a fall which caused him to be a paraplegic for the remainder of his life. He adapted well. Allen spent some time in a nursing home and some time with family.

He is survived by his two brothers Rex Elkins and wife Karen of Henryetta, Oklahoma and Ricky Elkins and his wife Kae of Sentinel, Oklahoma, and former wife Sharon, nieces Bridget, Heather, and Kyla, nephews Cody and Kraig, and a host of other relatives and friends. Allen was preceded in death by his parents Carol and Eleanor Elkins, his son Austin Elkins, sister Donna

Gifford, and nephews Kyle and Ryan Elkins.
