



Arthur Nicks "Nick" Armstrong

January 20, 1936 - February 24, 2019

Arthur Nicks "Nick" Armstrong longtime Lone Wolf resident passed from this life on February 24, 2019 in Hobart at age 83. He was born on January 20, 1936 in Hollis Oklahoma to Archie Nicks Armstrong and Thelma Inez "Card" Armstrong. Nick attended Lone Wolf School and was a proud Coyote Graduate in 1954 and in February of 1956 Nick joined the United States Navy Reserve serving during Peacetime duty as an Aviation Fire Control Technician, Third Class. He returned home after being discharged in Norfolk, Virginia in November of 1957 and on July 6, 1958 he married the love of his life Geneva Fay Blevins in Lone Wolf and to this union was born three daughters, Cynthia, Terri and Karla. Nick continued his education at Southwestern Oklahoma State University at Weatherford and in 1965 received his Bachelor of Science in Education. Nick and Geneva taught and lived in various places such as Thomas, Okla., Cordell, Okla., Smith Center, Kansas, (while here he received his Master of Education in 1970 and was a member of the Masonic Lodge #137), Syracuse, Kansas then returning home here at Lone Wolf. He taught at WOSTC in Burns Flat helping students in their Job Placement. He then began a career at OSR in Granite retiring after a number of years. Together with Geneva and several other friends, Nick received training as an EMT and started an ambulance service in Lone Wolf, volunteering for over ten years. He operated the first Public Housing Authority in Lone Wolf, was a longtime member of the Church of Christ, Nick especially enjoyed visiting and loved for people to stop by, he and Geneva also loved

music and would travel to festivals, and he also loved to collect guns and knives..

Nick is survived by Geneva of the home, daughters, Cynthia Lynn Jones of Lone Wolf, Terri Elaine Meinert and husband Mark also of Lone Wolf and Karla Ann Forehand and husband Monty of Loveland, Colorado. Nick leaves a legacy of six grandchildren, Cody Meinert of Lone Wolf, Calen Meinert and wife Kelli of Sayre, Lucas Forehand of Nashville, TN, Cory Meinert and wife Chelsea of Lone Wolf, Kalli Forehand of Loveland, CO and Jacy Standerfer and husband Matthew of Lone Wolf and four great-grandchildren, Kyler Forehand, Marlee Meinert, Sawyer Meinert and Graham Nyx. Nick is also survived by a host of other relatives and friends.
