



## Bernadine Jean Price Stovall

December 29, 1927 - January 4, 2020

Bernadine Stovall, 92, of Altus, Oklahoma, passed away January 4, 2020, in Lawton, Oklahoma. She was born December 29, 1927, in Hobart, Oklahoma, to Laurence E. and Bertha Price. She was the eldest of five children. She attended Lone Wolf Public School where she participated in Band and Basketball. After a Lone Wolf vs. Granite girl's basketball game, she met the handsome guy who had been scorekeeper, Jack Stovall. They dated a few times then he joined the Army. But he returned and on August 15, 1944, at the ages of 16 and 18, they were married. She was just beginning her Junior year. She graduated from Lone Wolf High in 1946. After four children she decided to go to Cameron College where she made all A's; however, her goal of obtaining a degree was cut short when she had their fifth child. As the children got older, she worked outside the home as a secretary at Fort Sill, Oklahoma, and again at Fort Richardson, Alaska. Bernadine was an excellent helpmate to her husband, wonderful mother to their five children, devoted grandmother and great grandmother, excellent cook, diligent housekeeper, and a good friend to all. Bernadine and Jack were married just one month short of 74 years. She has been a faithful member of the Church of Christ all of her married life. She was preceded in death by her husband Jack Stovall, her son Jerry David Stovall Sr., her parents, Laurence and Bertha Price, sister Donna George, and brother, Homer Price. She is survived by son Larry Stovall and his wife Janie of Poteau, OK; daughter LaDonna Armstrong and her husband Bill, of Surprise, AZ; son Jack Stovall, Jr. and his wife Linda, of Austin, Texas;
