Berta Faye Mullennix Cain passed from this life on April 20, 2026, in Oklahoma City at the age of 90. She was born on May 25, 1935, on a farm near Carter, OK to George Bert and Ruby Jewel (Vitato) Mullennix. Berta's job was to herd the cows in from the pasture, then help milk. She attended Carter schools and graduated in 1953. Berta sang in the high school and church choirs and excelled at basketball in junior high and high school until an injury sidelined her game. The Mullennixes were a musical family. Her dad played many instruments including piano, guitar, mandolin and a fiddle while the family sang beautiful harmonies. Berta and her family made time pass quickly on long-distance trips by singing on the way. Before home air conditioners were common, the family sat outside in the late evenings, played instruments, and sang. August 8, 1952, Berta and Teddy Lee Cain were married. To this union two sons were born, Mark Wayne and Dennis Lee. Ted and Berta lived in Carter, Clinton, Blair, and finally settled in Altus in 1962. Berta served as a longtime Sunday school teacher at First Assembly of God and held Nursing Home services on Sunday mornings before church started. She worked as a receptionist for several years at what is now the Integris Medical Clinic in Altus. Berta loved music, basketball, traveling, and reading. She also loved to create crafts, and shared her made up stories with her grandsons, and entertained them with treasure hunts. Berta loved the Lord, her family, and friends. She is survived by her two sons, Mark Cain (wife Cheryl) of Oklahoma City and Dennis Cain of Vernon, (ex-wife Cheryl Cain of Elmer) and her sister

Joyce Chandler of Elk City. Berta's legacy is carried on by her four grandsons- Matthew Cain (wife Casey) of OKC, Micah Cain (wife Deanna) of Mustang, Gregory Cain (wife Samantha) of Altus, and Derrick Cain of Elmer. 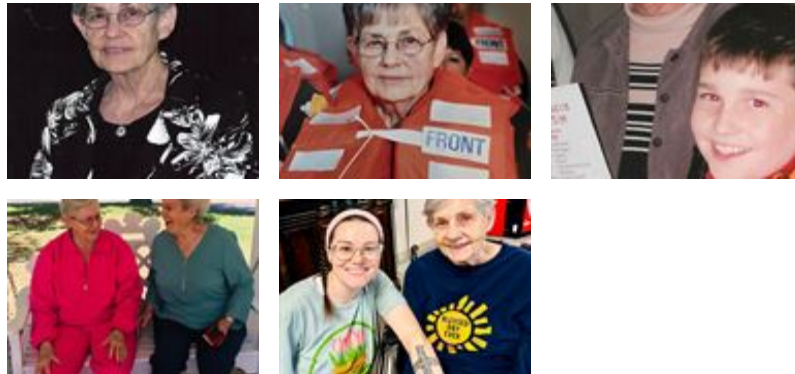
