Billie Dean (Kifer) Stimson went to be with her Lord on May 29, 2016 at the age of 88. Billie was born on July 12, 1927 to Roy and Rosie May (Allen) Kifer in Cushing, Oklahoma. Billie was a member of the United Methodist Church in Granite and a member of the American Legion Ladies Auxiliary.
