Billy George Colson passed away on August 16, 2020 at age 68 in Altus, Oklahoma. He was born on December 6, 1951 to George Columbus Colson and Beatrice (Blair) Colson in Mangum, Oklahoma. 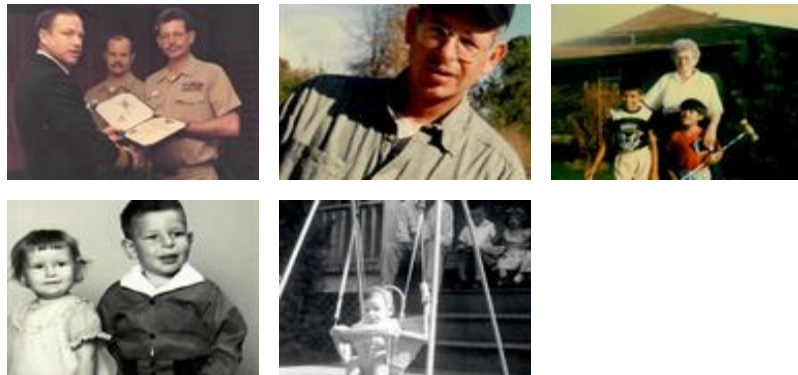
