March 24, 1932 - August 9, 2020

Bobby Gene Davis was born March 24, 1932 and passed from this life on August 9, 2020 at the age of 88 years, 4 months and 15 days following a long battle with Alzheimers. He was born in Erick, Oklahoma to A.D. (Alfred David) Davis and Lillie Maud (Holland) Davis. He attended school in Erick, graduating from high school in 1950. He joined the United States Air Force in 1951 and proudly served his country for nine years. Bobby is survived by his children, Lia Kaye (Davis) Spears, Kevin Glen Davis, and Diane Laree (Davis) Craig; his step children, Mary Copeland and Paul Benoist; his sister, Naomi Dillard; and numerous grandchildren, great grandchildren, and great, great grandchildren as well as many nieces and

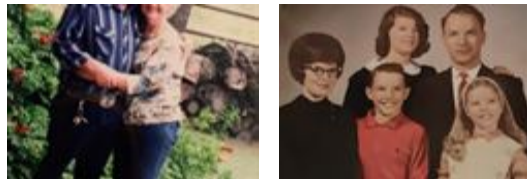

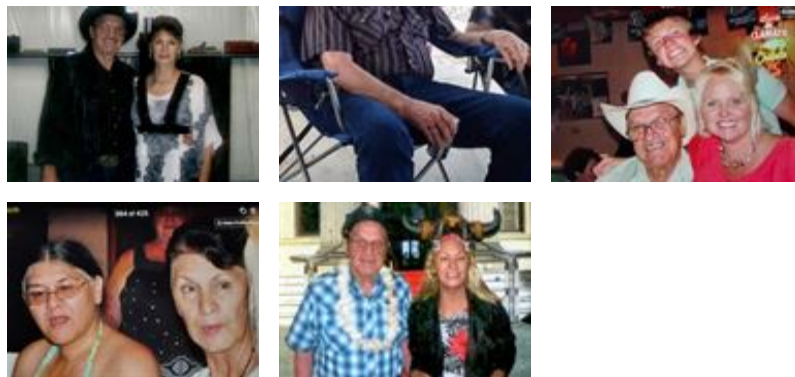
