Brandon George Hanlin passed away on February 1, 2015 in Lone Wolf. He lived 53 years, 4 months, and 17 days. Brandon was born September 15, 1961 at Hobart, Oklahoma. He was the fifth child born to Dorothy Jean and David Allen Hanlin. He grew up in Lone Wolf and attended church at the First Christian Church in Lone Wolf and became a Christian at a young age. He graduated from Lone Wolf High School in May, 1979 at the age of 17. He was a good athlete participating in football, baseball, and basketball. Right after graduation he went to work in the oil field. He married Lisa Stoup on November 27, 1981 and made their home in Lone Wolf. Two children were born to that union; Landon George Hanlin and Colton Tyrel Hanlin. Brandon later went to work at Bar S in Altus, CR Industries in Hobart, and Bo Weevils Eradication in Hobart. He and Lisa recently celebrated thirty-three years together. He enjoyed family and friends and fishing. Brandon was an avid OU Sooner football and basketball fan and an Oklahoma City Thunder fan. Brandon loved children and always had candy for them. Brandon loved to cook and helped prepare lots of family meals. Brandon had a kind heart and would help anyone in need.
