Carroll Duane Grady, age 75, a resident of Snyder, Oklahoma, passed away at the Comanche County Memorial Hospital in Lawton, Oklahoma, Tuesday, November 3, 2015. Carroll was born in Amarillo, Texas on May 20, 1940 to Cass Grady and Audra (Hogan) Grady. Carroll was a graduate of Granite High School and then went on to join the National Guard and later became a prison guard at OSR where he retired as a Captain. On March 16, 1960, he married the love of his life, Patricia Ann Lovitt, in Midland, TX. To this union were born three daughters, Stephanie, Christi, and Kelly. The couple began raising their family in California before moving to Granite in the early seventies. They moved to Snyder in 2002 where they lived until their deaths. In Carroll's earlier years he loved to fish and play dominos but his true gift was being a self-taught musician who loved to play the guitar & piano but could just about play anything you set before him. Carroll was a member of the Lake Creek Baptist Church and even wrote a song about it. He loved all babies and small children. He would always take the time to talk to them and give them a dollar.
