



Cecil B. Perryman

April 9, 1930 - December 1, 2018

Long time Duke resident Cecil B. Perryman entered his heavenly home on December 1, 2018 in Altus at the age of 88. Cecil was born on April 9, 1930, in Duke, Oklahoma to Barnett “Barney” and Eunice (Roberts) Perryman. He graduated from Central View in 1948. Cecil hauled wheat and cotton, delivered bricks for Mangum Brick Company, and drove a transport truck for Mangum Oil & Gas. In 1968 he began delivering propane to local customers for Mangum Oil & Gas and continued this for twenty-two years. On September 8, 1950, Cecil married Jewel Passmore and they had three children: Larry, Linda, and Sharon. On August 28, 1984, he married Glenda Nichols Maddox at the First Baptist Church in Russell, Oklahoma. Cecil and Glenda enjoyed 34 years together. Cecil loved to work no matter how difficult the job was. He loved to build fence, and also working with his cattle. Anything to do with the farm was a pleasure. He said, “The Lord has given it to me to take care of and I will do the best I can.” He was constantly mowing the ditches on all the land he farmed, and he would also mow neighbors’ ditches. He didn’t believe in driving down the road when he could mow a ditch! Cecil loved helping people. He would use his tractor and fuel just to help others get their plowing done. If someone came to his home at noon, he would ask that person to stay for lunch. Cecil always wanted to share what he had. He loved to give money to the children at church, and also to his grandchildren and great grandchildren as well when they came to see him. Cecil loved to visit with people. He was a very caring person and he did a lot for others that no one knew about. More

importantly, Cecil loved the Lord and was a good Christian man.

Cecil is survived by his wife, Glenda, of the home; a son and daughter-in-law, Larry and Jareta Kay Perryman of Mangum, OK; a daughter and son-in-law, Linda and Terry Brooks of Lindsay, OK; a daughter and son-in-law, Sharon and Mike Montgomery of Roosevelt, OK; and a special niece, Carol Ann Tiernan and husband Mike of Amarillo, TX. There are three stepsons and wives: Kent and Julie Maddox of Denton, TX; Ronnie and Terry Maddox of Mangum, OK; and Herman and Karen Maddox of Vernon, TX. Cecil leaves a legacy of thirteen grandchildren, thirty-four great grandchildren, one great-great grandson and a host of other relatives and friends.

Cecil was preceded in death by his parents, Barnett and Eunice Perryman and his sister, Vera Lois House.
