Chad Aron Sullins passed from this life Sunday, June 27, 2021 in Altus, Oklahoma at the age of 43. He was born October 7, 1977 to Marsha Sullins in Hobart, Oklahoma.

Chad is survived by his mother Marsha, son Corbin, daughters Presley and Madison, brothers Brad and Randy, sister Gena, Aunt Tonya, Uncle Rick, and

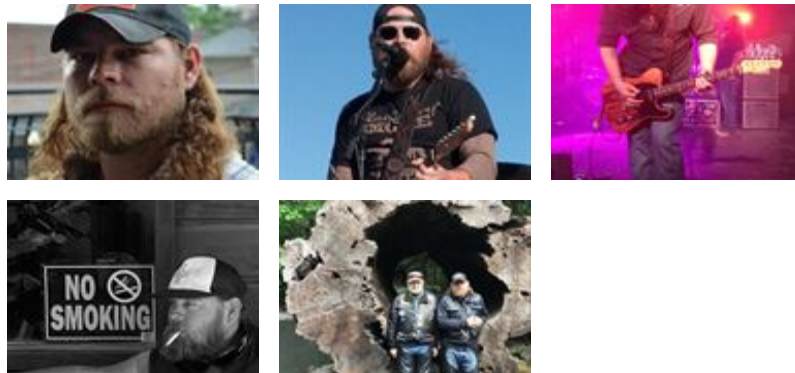
