



Charles Earon Winters

October 15, 1936 - May 22, 2017

Charles Earon Winters passed from this life to his heavenly home on May 22, 2017 at Jackson County Memorial Hospital at age 80. He was born on October 15, 1936 to Charlie and Effie (Southall) Winters in Blair, Oklahoma. Charles was the second of seven children. The son of a sharecropper, his family moved to the Bay Area in California when he was five years old. They lived in Brentwood, CA when Pearl Harbor was bombed, then in San Francisco, CA where Charles remembered enduring city-wide blackouts during WWII. On his sixth birthday his family moved back to Oklahoma.

At eighteen Charles married the love of his life, Melva Brooks on September 30, 1955. Charles worked for his father doing drywall and painting then worked for Consolidated Gas or Arkla-gas from which he retired after 39 years. Charles enjoyed working on the farm, running cattle and loved his trips to Colorado to go deer hunting, but Charles especially enjoyed his children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren above all else. Charles served as a deacon for fifty years at the House of Prayer Church in Blair.

Charles was preceded in death by his parents Charlie & Effie, brother Robert Winters, sister Brenda Traffanstedt, daughter Yvonne Hart and infant sister Mary.

He is survived by wife Melva of the home, daughters Charlotte Owen and

husband Jack, Darlene Davis and husband Gary, Myrna Cross and husband Jay and Lola Wiley and husband Steve all of Blair, sons Greg Winters and wife Amy of Blair and Luis Perez of Altus.
