Clifton D. Lee, 91, of Hobart, Oklahoma went to be with his Heavenly Father on Thursday, December 22, 2011.

He was born October 25, 1920 in Hobart, Oklahoma to James J. and Della A. Lee. Clifton graduated from Hobart High School in 1939.

Clifton married the love of his life, Myra McLain on May 12, 1940; they were married for 67 years.

He served in the Army Air Corps from 1942-1944 as an Aerial Engineer and later finished Pilot Officers Training School. Clifton farmed until retiring in 1985.

Clifton was preceded in death by his parents, his loving wife Myra in 2007, one daughter, Lynda Estrella in 1985 and one sister, Dorothy Wilma Davis in 2011.
