Darrell Richard Hohmann, more commonly known as, “Papa Darrell” was born on June 1, 1940 in Elk City, Oklahoma to Arthur and Emma Hohmann. He passed away May 19, 2018 in Hobart, Oklahoma at the age of 77. Darrell attended Lone Wolf Public Schools. After graduation, he attended the University of Oklahoma. While at OU, he was a member of the OU basketball team.
