Dennis Irvin Hendrix, Sr. was born to Bricen Lee and Inez Ulalia (Reeves) Hendrix in Hobart, Oklahoma on April 28, 1945 and departed this life in Clinton, Oklahoma on December 2, 2012 at the age of 67 years, 7 months and 4 days.

Dennis grew up in Hobart where he attended school until he enlisted in the U.S. Army in 1961 during the Vietnam War. Once discharged he married Betty Thomas on July 17, 1964 in Dodge City, Kansas and they made their home in Hobart where they raised their family. Dennis was their owner operator of H & H amusement with his brother Ronnie for 3 years. He and Betty owned the Office Bar for 15 years until 1995. He went to work for Circle S Paving in 1994. He loved his job and the people he worked with.

He was preceded in death by his parents, a son, Cory Hendrix, a brother Ronnie Hendrix and a sister Angie Pool.
