Dollie Elizabeth Banks was born to Andrew Jackson and Girtha Hendrix (Roden) Nowell in Soper, Oklahoma on August 15, 1927 and departed this life in Mangum, Oklahoma on January 8, 2013 at the age of 85 years, 4 months and 23 days.

Dollie grew up in Plainview, OK, where she graduated High School. She married Cowley Carl Banks on November 29, 1946 and they made their home north of Mangum, OK before moving to Willow, OK in 1962. She received her BA from Southwestern State College, Weatherford, OK and became a 4th grade teacher at Dill City for 22 years before retiring.
