Donna Faye (Grady) Russell passed from this life on June 9, 2021, age 77, at home with family by her side. Faye was born on May 16, 1944, the daughter of Cass and Audra (Hogan) Grady. She was the last child born at the family farmhouse near Willow, Okla. After graduating from Granite High School in 1962 she lived in Midland, Texas, California and again in Ft. Worth, returning to Granite in 1989. Faye married Leroy Russell in 1972 and he preceded her in death in 2009. She spent most of her working life caring for others as a CNA working in nursing homes, babysitting or private duty.

Faye was preceded in death by her parents, Cass and Audra Grady, five sisters: Winona Graham, Joyce Hayes, Helen Blair, Mary Lou Cross and Gaye Crump, three brothers: Cecil, Paul and Carroll Grady.

She is survived by niece Crissy Wright and nephew Pete Aydelotte and wife Michelle, sister Sue Everhart and husband Jim, brothers Joe Grady and Eddie Grady and wife Sharon. Faye is also survived by numerous nieces, nephews and a host of other relatives and friends.
