Dorecia Von Tepe passed from this life on September 25, 2021, at home surrounded by family at the age of 72. One of her favorite hobbies was gardening, which enabled her to easily supply the whole family (and then some) with fresh vegetables. She was a longtime member of the St. John's Lutheran Church in Lone Wolf, where her faith in

God was strong. She was the rock and glue of the family and always hosted Thanksgiving and Christmas each year, which was full of laughter and wonderful memories.

She is survived by her husband of the home Jimmy, son Jerry Paul Tepe and wife Amber of Lone Wolf, granddaughter Jerra Jo Tepe, grandsons Mason Philip Tepe and Levan Paul Tepe. Dorecia is also survived by a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends. She was preceded in death by her parents, Jerry and June Smith, son Philip James Tepe and sister Jerrie Sue Pearson.
