April 18, 1927 - December 28, 2014

Dorothy Hood, age 87, a longtime resident of Willow, Oklahoma, passed away, Sunday, December 28th, 2014 at Sayre Memorial Hospital in Sayre, Oklahoma.

Dorothy was born in Canute, Oklahoma on April 18th, 1927 to James Willard and Zula Irene (Siniard) Newberry. Dorothy graduated from Canute High School class of 1943.
