Dorothy Sue Petzold (McClendon), 82, of Childress, Texas, passed away on October 17, 2024. Sue was born on July 27, 1942, in Childress, Texas, to Merle Adeline Harris and Claude O'Neal McClendon. She spent her formative years in Childress, where she was lovingly raised by her mother and father Bill Dawson surrounded by her siblings and cousins. After a life of frequent moves and new beginnings, Sue then returned to Childress where her story began. On July 29, 1967, Sue married her soulmate, Donald Ray Petzold. Their 38 years together were filled with farming, working in town, raising children, and cherishing time spent with their grandchildren. In addition to her dedication to family, Sue enjoyed a fulfilling career as a supervisor at Altus Athletics and as a bookkeeper for Petzold Services, Inc. However, her most cherished roles were those of Mother, Grannie, Nana, and fierce protector of her loved ones. Sue had a passion for creativity, expressing herself through crocheting, knitting, painting, and sewing. Multiple paintings that she completed hung in her and her families' homes, and while she would tell you that making college blankets for her grandchildren was the absolute worst, she happily completed them by each graduation, swearing each one was her last. As devoted members of St. John's Lutheran Church in Granite, Oklahoma, Sue and Don's faith was an integral part of their lives. So much in fact that they sat in the same church pew every Sunday surrounded by family. Together, they also enjoyed supporting Navajo Public schools through their kids and grandkids. They became ardent supporters of the American Red Cross after their home

was destroyed by a tornado in 1975 and the organization provided much needed aid. Sue is survived by her son, Michael Lewis Moran and wife Lisa of Willow Park, Texas; daughter, Lisa Gail Davis of Oklahoma City, Oklahoma; and Donald Ray Petzold Jr. of Lone Wolf, Oklahoma.
