Edra Necie Harris was born at Plainview, Oklahoma on June 23, 1913 to Jerome Buford Harris and Ida Caladona Hill Harris. Edra went to be with her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on March 20, 2015 at Cordell Memorial Hospital in Cordell, Oklahoma. She grew up in the Plainview community and graduated from Mangum High School in May 1931. She began teaching school at Plainview shortly after she graduated from high school. Edra attended Southwestern College in Weatherford in the summers and during school vacations. She graduated from college in 1944 with a Bachelor of Education degree. She completed her Master of Education degree at Southwestern in 1956. She taught school at Plainview, Lake Creek, Midway, Ozark and Granite public schools. She taught school for 41 years.

Edra was married to Hurley Bryant McClung on January 22, 1937 in Altus, Oklahoma. They had one daughter, Janet Kaye.
