Elmer Koester was born to Herman Koester and Margaret (Felter) Koester in Lone Wolf, Oklahoma on June 18, 1931 and departed this life in Hobart, Oklahoma on October 17, 2014 at the age of 83 years, 3 months, and 29 days.

Elmer grew up in Lone Wolf where he graduated from high school in 1949. He was a lifelong member of the St. John's Lutheran Church in Lone Wolf and was baptized as child on July 5, 1931.
