Ernest Wayne Wood passed from this life on December 7, 2017 in Sulphur at age 86. Ernest was born on September 16, 1931 in Hobart, Oklahoma to Ernest Benjamin Wood and Ethel E. (Deaton) Wood. He attended all of his school years in Ardmore and graduated in 1949. He joined the National Guard in February of 1947 and joined the Army on September 1, 1950. He served in the Korean War and was honorably discharged in April of 1952 at Ft. Sill. Ernest was a mechanical engineer in the Aircraft Division, played a key role in determining how well the Government operates and received special recognition from President Reagan because his efforts enabled the Government to function better at less cost to the taxpayer, had a patent for a wide guide self-centering boat loading system, loved to work on cars, liked photography, country and western music, especially Hank Williams Sr., his life and his story interested Ernest and he was an avid Daily Oklahoman reader.

Ernest is survived by two sons; Durward Wayne Wood of Moore, Oklahoma and Marvin Lyn Wood and wife Rebecca of Choctaw and, two grandchildren; Michael Wood and Sheila Wood and one great-granddaughter Brittany. Ernest was preceded in death by his parents and grandson Brandon Wood.
