



## Eugene D. Sanders

March 1, 1936 - November 1, 2017

Eugene D. Sanders, long time Kiowa County resident passed from this life on November 1, 2017 at age 81. Eugene was born on March 1, 1936 in Hobart, Oklahoma, to Everett L. Sanders and Sarah Jane (Reed) Sanders. He grew up and attended school in Lone Wolf graduating in 1954. After graduation Eugene attended Altus Junior College and then OCC. He married Beth Lobaugh, on June 12, 1953 in Vernon, Texas. Eugene served in the United States Army from 1955 to 1957. He retired from S.W. Bell Telephone Company after 25 years in April of 1980.
