January 25, 1942 - March 18, 2024

Floyd Calvin Newton passed from this life on March 18, 2024, in Borger, Texas, at age 82. Calvin was born on January 25, 1942, in Hobart, Oklahoma to Floyd Albert Newton and Edna (Wheeler) Newton. He attended Lone Wolf Schools, where he excelled in sports, especially baseball. After graduating, Calvin was offered five full ride scholarships to play ball, he chose OU. He married the love of his life Linda Kay McCrady in 1961, at the First Assembly of God parsonage in Lone Wolf. Calvin was sought out by many Scouts to play professional baseball in which he signed with the Cincinnati Reds to play in New York. They moved to New York to play baseball for 1 year. They then moved to Rocky Mountain, North Carolina for his second season. While playing, Calvin began to feel the call of the ministry. He decided to pursue the ministry and voluntarily retired. They then moved to Oklahoma City, OK to study for the ministry in which led them to their first church in Ringling, OK. From there they pastored churches in Oklahoma, New Mexico, and Texas. He retired after 56 years in the ministry. Calvin and Linda enjoyed 63 years of marriage before his passing. He was an avid sportsman, loved fishing, finding his way back to Oklahoma fishing ponds every chance he got, tinkering with cars, and was a topnotch handyman. Calvin especially loved his family, showed Christian love and the example of Christ in his life. He is survived by his wife Linda of the home, three sons, Quenton Newton and wife Paula of Healdton, Oklahoma, Brett Newton and wife Lisa of Houston, Texas and Troy Newton of Pampa, Texas, daughter Lindsay Vessels and husband Jeremy of

Borger, Texas, brother-in-law Larry McCrady and wife Frankie of Canyon, Texas, sixteen grandchildren, numerous great grandchildren, nieces, nephews and a host of other relatives and friends.
