



## Gayle Leslie Dobbs

September 24, 1928 - May 27, 2012

Gayle Leslie Dobbs was born to Alvin Henry and Elsie Lottie (Elloit) Dobbs in Dill City, Oklahoma on September 24, 1928 and departed this life in Rocky, Oklahoma on May 27, 2012 at the age of 83 years, 8 months and 3 days. Gayle attended school in Gotebo, Fay, Port and Rocky until he was drafted into the U.S. Army in 1951 at Camp Chaffee, Arkansas. He was released from service in 1953 after a tour in Korea.
