



## Geneva Fay Armstrong

February 14, 1939 - August 15, 2025

Geneva Fay Armstrong, longtime Lone Wolf resident, passed from this life on August 15, 2025, surrounded by family, at age 86. She was born on Valentine's Day, February 14, 1939, in Blanchard, Oklahoma to Lester Blevins and O'Leva Dell (Sunderland) Blevins. Geneva attended Lugert School from 1945 to 1947, then moved to Lone Wolf and attended Lone Wolf Schools for ten years graduating in 1957. Then on July 6, 1958, she married the love of her life Arthur Nicks "Nick" Armstrong in Lone Wolf, Oklahoma and to this union they were blessed with three daughters, Cynthia, Terri and Karla. Geneva and Nick lived in various places such as Thomas, OK, Cordell, OK, Smith Center, KS, and Syracuse KS. While Nick was teaching, Geneva worked for a dentist in Smith Center. While living in Syracuse, she worked for the Hamilton County Treasurer's Office. They returned home to Lone Wolf in 1973. She began work at the

Department of Human Services in 1974 in Hobart, retiring after twenty-two years of service as a Clerk Typist. Together, Geneva, Nick and several other friends received training as EMTs and started an ambulance service in Lone Wolf, volunteering for over ten years. She also served on the Lone Wolf Senior Citizens Board. Geneva was a longtime member of the Church of Christ. Geneva and Nick loved music and would travel to festivals with friends. She was always thrilled when her grandsons played music for her and even traveled to watch them perform at various venues. Geneva was a true servant and loved cooking and feeding everyone! All her children's friends, her grandchildren and their friends and any other stray kids playing in the neighborhood. Geneva is survived by her three daughters, Cynthia Lynn Jones of Lone Wolf, Terri Elaine Meinert and husband Mark also of Lone Wolf and Karla Ann Forehand and husband Monty of Loveland, Colorado, brother Pat Blevins and sister Norma Ward.
