Glenda Lucille (Henry) Newton was born April 3, 1935, to Earl Henry and Lucille Coffelt Henry in Snyder, OK, where she spent her youth and attended school until she was 12 years old. Her family then moved to Carter, OK, where she attended and graduated from Carter High School in 1953.

Glenda met her future husband, Dale Newton, in Carter, OK, where they were married on July 26, 1953. After marriage, the couple moved to Lone Wolf, OK, where they made their home and raised a family.
