Harold Albert Pruitt passed from this life on January 21, 2025, at home at age 83. He was born on January 1, 1942, to Albert and Ora (Wilson) Pruitt in Hobart and grew up on the family farm. Harold attended Hobart Schools and was a Bearcat graduate. He married Elva Marie Flynn on August 24, 1963, in Mangum, and they were blessed with two sons, Wendell and Craig.
