Jack Allen McGinnis was born on August 1, 1943 to Spurgon Dudly McGinnis and Gracie (Smith) McGinnis and departed this life on October 22, 2014 at the age of 71 years, 2 months, and 21 days.

Jack grew up on a farm in Friendship under the care of his grandparents, George and Nannie McGinnis. He served as an E5 drill sergeant in the United States Army, the Oklahoma Army National Guard, and Army Reserves. There he also served as a Correctional Specialist and Military Police Officer. He received the National Defense Service Metal/Sharpshooter Qualification Badge Rifle, and the good conduct metal. In December of 1977, he was honorably discharged. As a civilian, Jack was a cleet certified officer and detective. He also worked many years at Gorden Cartons in Lawton, a guard at the Oklahoma State Reformatory in Granite, and later at SKF in Hobart. Many remember him as an avid young motorcyclist, who enjoyed every minute on his Harley Davidson. He spent his later years with a very special companion, Sarah Ann Godfrey in Lone Wolf. They each enjoyed the company of family and friends. They stayed young at heart, always laughing and pulling jokes. Jack was a true friend to many, who will deeply missed.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Spurgon and Gracie McGinnis; very
