James Joseph Henry "Captain" passed away peacefully on November 14, 2020 in Hobart, Oklahoma. James was born in Stonington, Connecticut on September 25, 1929, the youngest of eight children of Antone and Maria Henry.

Captain began his fishing career as a Lobsterman at an early age of sixteen in Stonington, Connecticut, where he fished the Long Island Sound from Fishers Island, New York to Block Island, Rhode Island. He established the family business J & J Lobster Market and distributed commercially to restaurants for many years. In later years he worked for General Dynamics in Groton, Connecticut as a submarine painter. Upon retiring and moving to Oklahoma in 2005, he enjoyed playing golf, bowling, bingo and traveling with his beloved wife Wilda.

He is survived by his children James Glen Henry and wife Angela of Yukon, OK, Sharon Meinert of Hobart, OK, Carol Meinert and husband Monte of Lone Wolf, OK, Donna Jones and husband Buddy of Hobart, OK, and Kathan Teale of Victoria, British Columbia, Canada, 13 grandchildren, 14 great grandchildren, and one brother Joe Henry of North Carolina.

He was preceded in death by his wife Wilda, his parents, 2 brothers, 4 sisters, and a son-in-law.
