John Douglas Tice passed from this life on March 1, 2026, in Mangum, at age 84. He was born on February 7, 1942, in Harmon County, north of Hollis to Hurnice and Esther (Weaver) Tice. After graduating from high school, Doug went straight into the Army serving around 4 years. He then worked as a used car salesman, service station attendant, owned and operated a cafe, but worked farm labor the majority of his adult life. When he was a dog catcher for the City of Hollis, he met Wanda Sue Howard, and they were married on August 3, 1973, in Childress, Texas, enjoying 47 years of marriage before her passing in 2020.
