



Jonny Alfred Johnson

June 18, 1928 - May 24, 2023

Jonny A. Johnson passed from this life on May 24, 2023 in Sayre, OK at the age of 94. He was born June 18, 1928 in Cordell, OK to his parents Ira M. Johnson and Ida (Schneberger) Johnson. Jonny grew up and attended school in Burns Flat, OK, graduating at the top of his class as valedictorian in 1946. After graduation, Jonny ventured to California where he rebuilt motorcycles at his Uncle Jack's shop. A year or so later he returned to Oklahoma, settled down in Dill City, and joined a construction crew where he worked as their motor grade operator, building local highways. In 1950, Jonny decided to enlist into the United States Army. He attended engineering school and served as a combat engineer in Karlsruhe, Germany. He was honorably discharged in 1953 at the rank of Motor Sergeant. Around the same time that Jonny was enlisting, he met and dated a lovely young lady from Dill City named Anna (Ann) Moore. They fell in love and married April 28, 1951 in Ft. Benning, GA. To this union was born three sons, Michael Shonn, Robert, and Jack. After his discharge from the Army, Jonny and Ann returned to Dill City where they farmed for a few years before moving to Carter, OK where they raised their children and farmed the land. In 1962, Jonny and his wife started Johnson Fertilizer out of their home in Carter. The business was moved to Sayre, OK in 1964. Jonny spent his working life running his business. When he wasn't working, Jonny enjoyed spending time with his family on the farm, engineering plans, water skiing, flying, and traveling. Jonny is survived by his sons Robert Johnson and wife Nelda of Carter, and Jack Johnson and wife Deanna of Elk

City, sister Donna Kilhoffer of Dill City, six grandchildren; Jeffeory Johnson, Jonathan Johnson, Crystal Carel, Amy Johnson, Nikki Johnson, and Dallas Johnson, sixteen great grandchildren, one great-great granddaughter, and a host of other relatives and friends. He was preceded in death by his wife Anna Mae (Moore) Johnson, son Michael Shonn Johnson, brothers Mike and Donald Johnson, sisters Imogene Nichols and Mildred Thionnet.

Services for Jonny are scheduled for Tuesday, May 30, 2023, 2:00 P.M., at the First Baptist Church in Sayre. Interment will follow in Carter Cemetery with the United States Army performing graveside rites.
