Joyce Ann Pruitt, a longtime Kiowa County resident, passed from this life on May 14, 2025, at home with family by her side, at age 88. She was born on December 15, 1936, to Claude Price Winters and Muriel Maxine (Preslar) Winters, south of Lone Wolf on the farm, the family then moved to Chickasha for a few years, then moved south of Hobart where she grew up. She graduated as a Bearcat in 1955 and enjoyed playing basketball. Joyce attended Mount Teepee Baptist church where she married the love of her life, Jimmie Walter Pruitt on December 10, 1955. To this union three children were born. (Joyce and Jimmie were married for 59 years and 10 months before his passing.)
