Joyce Elaine Richardson was born to George and Esther (Roberts) Carothers in Granite, Oklahoma on May 16, 1936 and departed this life in Lone Wolf, Oklahoma on May 5, 2013 at the age of 76 years, 11 months and 19 days. Joyce grew up in and attended school in the Lake Creek community, later attending Granite High School before moving to Bell, California where she graduated in 1954. She met Walter R. "Bob" Richardson at the First Baptist Church, Bell, CA and was later married in East Los Angeles on July 2, 1953. She and Bob both accepted Christ as their Savior in April of 1953. She worked for Pacific Telephone and Telegraph for 5 years before becoming a stay at home mom. She was active in the Norco Valley 4-H as a project leader and the First Baptist Church of Norco, CA. the family moved to Lone Wolf in 1970 and she helped in the family business until they closed after Bob's death in 1991. She became an EMT in 1979 and served with the ambulance service until 1990. She was also a dispatcher for fire, police and ambulance service for 25 years. She worked for the U.S. Census Bureau as a Field Representative since 1983 because she loved to talk to people. She was a member of the First Baptist Church, Lone Wolf, where she was active and taught 1st and 2nd grade Sunday school for many years and dedicated Vacation Bible School Teacher for the Pre- K and Kindergarten classes. She was a member of the Lone Wolf and Granite American Legion Auxiliaries and served as Lone Wolf's Secretary and Treasurer for many years. She was a member of the B-U-Busy Home Extension Club and the

Golden Girls Service Group. Joyce was willing to help where ever was needed, as a Pink Lady at the Elkview General Hospital, Hobart or serving on the Lone Wolf Senior Citizens Center and the Lone Wolf Housing Authority Boards.

She was preceded in death by her husband, parents, a brother Ray Carothers and 4 sisters, Pearl Demarest, Mary Hutson, Ethel Witherspoon and Rita Coffman.
