Kenneth W. Felty of Hobart Ok passed away Sunday, April 17, 2016 in Norman Ok. He was 82 years old.

Kenneth was born on September 13, 1932 in Hollis, OK where he grew up and attended school. In 1950, he enlisted in the US Navy and served during the Korean War as a Seaman 1st Class. He was honorably discharged from service in 1953.

Kenneth was a longtime businessman in Altus OK, and owner of Ken Felty's Furniture for 11 years before retiring in 1979. During that time he hosted a morning radio show, "Swap Shop", and was known as "Crazy Ken - Long, Tall, Ball-headed and Thin."

He was an avid fisherman and spent his last years living in Boydsville, a small community near Lone Wolf, OK, on the north end of Lake Altus where he enjoyed many days at his favorite pastime.

He is survived by his sons and daughter-in-law; Rick and Wanda Felty of Norman, Ok, Tom and Cindy Felty of Duncan Ok and Tim Felty of Altus; six grandchildren, Casey, Morgan, Dustin, Shalynn, Kerrie and Kayla, and six great-grandchildren; Edison, Mazzie, Ari, Abram, Alice and Layne, and former spouse and longtime friend; Shirley Powers.

He was preceded in death by his father and mother; Emery and Mary Felty, and two sisters; Betty Sue and Ava Joy.
