



## Leomae "Weiss" Meinert

October 23, 1932 - November 18, 2021

Leomae "Weiss" Meinert was born October 23, 1932 to Leo and Nena Mae "Boyd" Weiss. Leomae attended Lone Wolf School from first grade to twelfth grade, where she received straight A's and had perfect attendance all twelve years. She was valedictorian of her senior class. After graduating high school, Leomae attended Business College in Lawton and later took a job at a bank in Hobart.

On May 3, 1953, she was united in marriage to Lloyd William Meinert at her family's home in Lone Wolf. They made their home in Lone Wolf, where they farmed and raised two sons, Michael Lloyd and Mark William. Leomae was a farmer's wife and homemaker, choosing to remain in the home while her boys were young.

When the boys were grown, Leomae took a job in Hobart, working for Sears. After several years, she was given a job at Southwest Veterinary Clinic in Hobart and worked as a receptionist and vet assistant until she retired. After losing Lloyd in 1982, she eventually remarried. In 1986 she married Willard "Buster" Savage of Granite and they were married 19 years before Buster's passing in 2005. Leomae eventually moved back to Lone Wolf to spend time with her family. Leomae was an avid sports fan and could always be seen at sporting events cheering on her children and grandchildren.

Leomae was preceded in death by her parents, Leo and Nena Weiss, her husband Lloyd Meinert, her sister, Janet Felter, husband Buster Savage, and great-granddaughter, Maizee Laine Meinert.

She is survived by son Mike and wife April of Lone Wolf, son Mark and wife Terri of Lone Wolf, Grandsons: Cody Meinert of Lone Wolf, Calen Meinert and wife Kelli of Sayre, OK. Cory Meinert and wife Chelsea of Lone Wolf, Brad Nickell and wife Tina of Lone Wolf, Terran and Will Meinert of Lone Wolf. Great-grandchildren: Marlee, Sawyer, Graham, Carsyn, Abigail and Chloe. 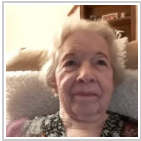
