Lloyd Henry Weber was born June 19, 1933 to Emma Neumann Weber and Fred Henry Weber, the fifth child and only son. He was educated in the Lone Wolf Schools, graduating in 1951. He served in the U.S. Army from 1952-1955 active duty and in the Army Reserve another 6 years until 1962.

After the service, Lloyd returned to the Lone Wolf community to pursue his lifelong passion of farming where he lived until his death June 19, 2018. He married Arnita Adkisson, a 'Mountain View girl' in 1956. They joined her father, H.L. Adkisson in the Custom Harvesting business shortly after their marriage.

The Adkisson/Weber crew not only cut wheat and corn; but, also, milo, soybeans, cotton, sunflowers, okra and watermelons until 2009 making dear, lifelong friends along the way. The crew followed the various harvests through Oklahoma, Texas, Arkansas, Mississippi, Kansas, Nebraska, Colorado, South and North Dakota, Wyoming and Montana. Through the years Lloyd trained and mentored many young boys who continue to be a part of his life- with a firm hand, a joke or two, visits to Mt. Rushmore and other sights along the way; always treating them as members of the large extended harvest family. Lloyd has been an active member of the Lone Wolf United Methodist Church since 1956, serving in a variety of capacities as the needs arose. He especially enjoyed using his musical gift as a member of the choir.

Lloyd was a member of the Masonic Lodge for 64 years achieving the status of 32 nd degree. He rarely missed a meeting or an annual trip to Guthrie. He used every opportunity to further the mission and values of the fraternity,

feeling deeply those values were consistent with his own.

Lloyd also was a determined advocate for public education. He served for 16 years on the Lone Wolf School Board. He also served 1 term on the State of Oklahoma School Board. In the 80's he served for 9 years on the AgPreference Board of Directors.

Lloyd loved to travel. He and Arnita enjoyed trips to a variety of locations especially enjoying traveling with family. Some of these destinations included New York City, Disneyworld, Mexico City, California, Connecticut, Boston and South Dakota and cruises in the Caribbean. The location still on his bucket list was Alaska.

Lloyd and Arnita became parents to Renae and four years later to Ronnie. Renae and her husband Neil live in Lone Wolf. Ronnie and his wife Laura live in Lone Wolf as well. Lloyd has 4 granddaughters, Whitney, Sarah and Rosie Vitale and Abby Weber. He was preceded in death by his wife of 59 years, Arnita Adkisson Weber, his parents and sisters. He leaves behind his sister-in-law and brother-in-law, Cheryl and Rick Zimmerman, a niece, Tara Zimmerman, a nephew, Todd Zimmerman as well as cousins, extended family, his church family and friends.
