November 6, 1936 - September 20, 2014

Lorene Faye Collins was born to George W. and Mollie (Hickman) Mixon in Boswell, Oklahoma on November 6, 1936 and departed this life in Altus, Oklahoma on September 20, 2014 at the age of 77 years, 10 months, and 14 days.
