Lurman George Helwer went to meet his Lord, October 24th, 2020, after a short illness at the Oklahoma Heart Hospital in Oklahoma City with all his family gathered by his side.

Lurman was born on April 26th, 1951 to Edward Lurman Helwer and Irene Mutilia (Myers) in Hobart, Oklahoma. He graduated from Hobart High School in 1969, and attended Southwestern State College, and graduated Dallas Institute of Mortuary Sciences in 1972.

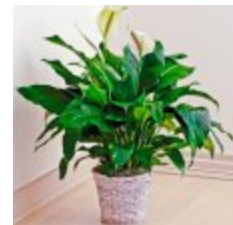

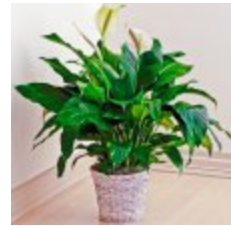
