Margy Eleanor Paquette was born to Joseph and Susan (Kirkpatrick) Paquette in Northampton, Massachusetts on September 13, 1931, about one year after her sister, Florence, and ten years after her brother, Wilfred. She was dubbed "Baby Marge" by her family, a name disliked by both Margy and Florence.

Margy attended Northampton public schools, graduating from Northampton High School.

During and after high school she worked as a babysitter, secretary, and an usherette in a local movie theater.

After graduation, she responded to an ad for civilian secretarial positions with the U.S. Army in Alaska and was hired. While working there, she met and subsequently married Darvin "Atch" Atchison, an Oklahoma native. After Atch completed his tour in Alaska, he and Margy moved to Altus, Oklahoma, where Margy worked for the local cable TV company. While living in Altus, they fostered and subsequently adopted two young boys, Darryl and Alton.

Margy later met and married Homer "Poss" Roberts on September 16, 1977, living on his farm and learning to drive a tractor, among other skills. She loved living at "The Old Home Place" with Poss. After Poss died suddenly on Jan. 3, 1990, Margy left the farm, moving to Granite, OK, making many friends. She joined First Baptist Church of Granite on February 11, 1990. She enjoyed teaching Sunday School, quilting, baking and Bible studies.

She passed away at age 90 on Dec. 23 2021 after a short illness.

She is predeceased by her parents, Joseph and Susan (Kirkpatrick) Paquette; her siblings, Wilfred Paquette and Florence (Paquette) Beyer; her husband Homer "Poss" Roberts and her sons, Darryl and Alton Atchison.

She is survived by her niece, Gail Beyer, many stepchildren and grandchildren, and some very dear friends.
