



## Marion Mildred Dunn

June 15, 1919 - December 2, 2020

Marion Mildred (Morris) Dunn of Lone Wolf, age 101, passed away on December 2, 2020 in Hobart, Oklahoma. She was born in Roff, Oklahoma in 1919. She moved to Lone Wolf in 1927 with her parents W.T. and Charlotte Morris, who edited and published the Lone Wolf News until the mid-1960s. Marion graduated from Lone Wolf High School in 1937, where she compiled an outstanding record in running track. She then graduated from Hills Business School in Oklahoma City. After that she moved to Lubbock, Texas, living with relatives while working there. But romance called her back to Lone Wolf, where on April 5, 1940, she married Robert P. "Bob" Dunn, Jr., a farmer and cattleman as well as a sandlot baseball coach, and to this union five children were born: Delmer, Mike, Pat, Jan Keegan, and Doug.

Marion was recognized as one of the best soprano voices in this part of the state. She was often asked to sing at funerals as well as special worship services. She was an active member of the First Baptist Church of Lone Wolf where she served as treasurer. She later became a member of the First Baptist Church of Granite where she especially enjoyed being a member of the Women's Bible Class.

Marion was very talented as a flower arranger, artist and greatly enjoyed many kinds of crafts. She was an active member of the Chrysanthemum Garden Club, carrying forth an interest of her mother, who was one of the

founders of the Pioneer Garden Club. After her children left home, she worked in several businesses in Lone Wolf, including Warren's Hardware, Schmidt's Grocery, and the local flower shop. Marion will be remembered for her many talents, but perhaps most of all, for her deep and abiding love for her children.

Marion is survived by four children: Delmer Dunn and wife Ann of Athens, Georgia, Pat Dunn and wife Marilyn of San Diego, California, Jan Keegan of Cleveland, Oklahoma, Doug Dunn and wife Jerri of Lone Wolf, and daughter-in-law Mary Dunn of Baytown, Texas, eight grandchildren, seven great grandchildren and a host of other relatives and friends.

She was preceded in death by her late husband Bob Dunn, her son Mike Dunn, her brother Victor Morris, sister Pauline Ball and an infant sister, Billie Louise and son-in-law, Tom Keegan.
