Mary Ann Lemaster, a resident of Mangum, passed away Wednesday, December 24, 2014 at the age of 103 at Grace Living Center in Mangum.

Mary was born in Stroud, Oklahoma on November 22, 1911 to George Washington McConnell and Flossie Lilly Dale (Mitchell) McConnell. Mary grew up in Stroud, OK, and then went on to live in Mountain View. On July 16, 1930, Mary married the love of her life, Andrew Jackson Lemaster in Anadarko.
