Michael Paul "Mike" Nahrgang, longtime Lone Wolf resident, passed suddenly from this life on January 18, 2023, at age 59. Mike was born on June 12, 1963, in Hobart, OK, to Harold Victor Nahrgang and Sandra Lou (Ernce) Nahrgang.

Mike loved spending time with his family and started every day having coffee with his mother, Sandra. He especially enjoyed attending his grandchildren`s birthday parties.

Mike and his wife Kathy made their home in Lone Wolf along with their precious dog, Casper. They enjoyed taking long drives together through the country, to see the changing seasons and to check out good hunting spots.

He loved to take his step-grandsons Chance and Chase hunting whenever they came down.

Mike is survived by his wife Kathy of the home, Mother Sandra Nahrgang, one daughter Chelsea Meinert and husband Cory, his brother Carey Nahrgang, and nephew Trevor Nahrgang, Step- daughter Deanna and Mike Willis. Mike leaves a legacy of six grandchildren, Marlee Brooke, Sawyer Shane, Carsyn Claire Meinert and step-grandchildren Tesla, Chase, and Chance Willis and one great step-granddaughter Kennedy Fief.
