Nicholas Petkoff was born to Mike and Mary (Wasilchin) Petkoff south of Hobart, Oklahoma on May 12, 1926 and departed this life in Norman, Oklahoma on April 30, 2013 at the age of 86 years, 11 months and 18 days. Nick grew up in Hobart, OK where he graduated High School and attended Junior College. He enlisted in the US Navy and served in Saipan during WWII. He married Shirley Adams in Hobart on May 27, 1948. He farmed for 17 yrs, was County Commissioner for 17 yrs and sold Caterpillar heavy equipment for 18 yrs. He owned a gas station and water ski school at Quartz Mountain for several yrs. He was a member of St. Marks Catholic Church, Norman. He enjoyed working in his yard, woodworking, craftwork and golf. He was preceded in death by his parents, a brother, Mike Petkoff Jr. and a sister Nettie Phelps.
