“ Dear Family of Obruni Linda,

*Sadly, I am sending this message after finding out that Linda Anderson has passed away. I met Linda in the Peace Corps while serving in northern Ghana. Despite being placed in the North, I met Linda in Accra after being invited to a Peace Corps sponsored meeting for budget forecasting. Back in our service locations we were separated by 200 miles and considerable obstacles, including government check points, waiting times to fill the transport to capacity, walking distances from the depots, bad dirt roads, etc. But we managed to see each other more often in my second year before my service time was up. I remember she spoke lovingly about her time in TX and OK. She had an adventurous spirit and was confident in her abilities to navigate a foreign way of life despite the obstacles in a male dominated culture. She was smart, energetic, and fun. At some vacation times we traveled in small groups of Peace Corps Volunteers (PCV) in the country. She was a terrific traveling mate and whenever I passed through Tamale, her base location, I would visit. We departed the country at different times and returned to the States at different times and places. We corresponded for a time but I lost track of her as we both got busy transitioning back to America.*

*It comes as a shock to hear of Linda's passing. A few years ago our Ghana PCV group, mostly educators from 1971-1973, began to hold reunions. Over these years I have been trying to locate Linda to invite her to our reunions. I extended this pursuit to others in our group and now after all this time, one of our colleagues just recently discovered this sad news.*

*I know this message comes out of the blue but I feel obligated to write, to express my condolences. Linda was a lovely person. It was a real loss for me to have lost connection. I hope she lived a wonderful and happy life. She deserved that. I'm sure we will talk of her and raise a tribute to her at the next reunion.*
