Patricia Mary "Helen" (Perez) Anderson, daughter of Victoria Cantu and Pete Perez, entered this world on June 29, 1932, in Washita, Oklahoma. Helen, as she was affectionately known by family and friends, left sickness and pain behind, and entered her heavenly home on March 17, 2016, at the age of 83 years, 8 months and 17 days.

Helen lost her mother, Victoria, when she was three years old so her grandmother, Susie, took over caring for her until her death in 1940. At that time, Helen went to live at the St. Patrick Catholic Mission in Anadarko, Oklahoma. She also lived with several other relatives at various times during her childhood. She especially enjoyed cooking, baking,

sewing and quilting. She was a member of the Soldier Spring School Club (The 3S Club) consisting of a group of neighbor ladies who would meet in each other's homes to sew and quilt. Billie and Helen were blessed by three children: two daughters and one son and they welcomed several nieces and nephews into their home throughout the years as well.

Helen accepted Christ as her savior as an adult. She was baptized and joined the First Baptist Church of Lone Wolf where she was an active member the remainder of her life. Helen lived her life following Christ's example; she was selfless, always thinking of others first and willing to go above and beyond what was expected of her. She was a loving wife, daughter-in-law, mother, mother-in-law, aunt, grandmother (great and great-great) and friend to many and will be missed by all whose lives she touched.
