Patsy Ruth Adams was born in Lone Wolf, Oklahoma to Curtis Adams and Ruby Harding Adams. She was one of four girls and a boy. She attended all of her school years at Lone Wolf schools. She was on the girls HS basketball team with her sister Shirley Adams. Patsy went to summer school to finish her senior year early so she could marry Dwain McMillan before he went into the Navy in September 1944. Their first child Pamela was born in late 1945. Patsy and Dwain started farming when he returned from the Navy. She once told the story of Dwain riding the tractor at night using lanterns for light. She could hear the tractor engine from the house. One night the tractor stopped and she was worried Dwain had fallen to sleep and been run over by the tractor. She got in the car and cut across the plowed rows to find him. Dwain had laid down between two rows to take a nap. He woke up with headlights jumping up and down and maybe a few harsh words from Patsy. Around 1950 they decided to leave the life of farming and moved to Tulare, California. Their next two children were born, Paula in 1951 and Steven in 1955. Patsy was pleased to have her growing family. In 1957 they moved to Odessa, Texas and later moved to Abilene, Texas. Patsy went to work at the city tax office, working there for over 15 years. Her main focus in life was her family. She was a terrific mother to her three children. Always there to guide and support them. She was blessed with three grandchildren that she loved unconditionally, and her six great grandchildren were the cherry on top. They all loved her and loved being with her.

Patsy and Dwain moved to Flower Mound, Texas to be near family.
