



## Phyllis Jean Hendricks

June 20, 1938 - July 4, 2023

Phyllis Jean Hendricks, 85, of Mangum, passed away Tuesday morning, July 4th, 2023, at Integris Baptist Medical Center in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Phyllis was born to Raymond Edward and Lydia Miranda McCollum on June 20, 1938, in Olustee, Oklahoma. As a little girl she lived on a farm several miles from Martha, Oklahoma. When Phyllis was 2-3 years old, her baby sister Patricia was born. They lost her after only a few months to whooping cough. A little less than six years later, Phyllis's sister Carolyn was born. They lived on the farm in a 4-room house and rode the school bus together during their school years. Phyllis played basketball and was an important part of the Martha basketball team. She started dating R.V. Hendricks in high school and they fell in love. They married July 24th, 1955, and moved to the Hester Community. She went to and graduated from Mangum High School her Senior year in 1956. After graduating, they moved to Mangum in 1957 where Phyllis worked in a dress shop and later as a telephone operator and worked several years as the First Baptist Church secretary. R.V. worked at a filling station and farmed until he was drafted by the Army in 1959. After basic training, they moved to Lawton, Oklahoma where they lived until 1961. During this time, Phyllis lost 3 baby boys to miscarriage. In 1960, Michael was born and 2 years later, Douglas came along. Eleven years later, in 1971, their daughter Sheila Jean was born. They lived in Mangum for their remaining 30 years of marriage. Phyllis moved to Oklahoma City in 1985. While living there, she worked as an apartment manager, was secretary for the Kentucky Avenue

Baptist Church and also worked for the Oklahoma State Insurance Commission until she moved back to Mangum for her retirement. She enjoyed going to church, working in her yard and spending time with family. She and R.V. neither remarried but found friendship and enjoyed family holidays together for the remainder of her life. She is survived by her two sons, Michael Hendricks and wife Tonya of Colony, Oklahoma, and Douglas Hendricks, of Mangum, daughter Sheila Warren and husband Wes of Shawnee, sister Carolyn Curtis and husband Nick of The Woodlands, Texas. Phyllis leaves a legacy of grandchildren: Micha Osloond and husband William, Schuyler Parnes and husband Jason, Jakeb Isch, Skylar Taylor, Payton Porter and husband Grayson, Bryce Warren and Jase Warren, greatgrandchildren: Cade, Brixton, Bralyn, Addelyn, Lincoln, Whitley, Landon, Lane and Laiken. She was preceded in death by her parents Raymond Edward and Lydia Miranda McCollum and infant sister Patricia.

Services for Phyllis are scheduled for Wednesday, July 12, 2023, 2:30 P.M. at the First Baptist church in Mangum with Pastor Shawn Johnson officiating. Interment will follow in Martha Cemetery.
